



Game Day Hints -KICKBALL

1. Get a dugout parent to help with the lineup (kicking) order, etc. Have them get the kids ready, so when it's their turn to kick, they are ready to go up to the plate.
2. Write the players names on tape and put it on the benches in the order they are batting, they can also place their personal items, etc by their place on the bench.
3. Ask parents to write names on their personal kickballs or other items.

Practice Hints

Simulate a game on the first day...

Have 3 players in for kicking, the rest are in correct positions in the field

1. one at the plate (ready to kick)
2. two on deck waiting to kick.

The rest of the players will be in positions.....coach will throw the designated number of pitches (rolls) to the batter (kicker) and simulate the game.....you have to have parents in the field with you to make this work as you work on the fundamentals right then after they catch and or throw. After each batter (kicker) goes through twice, rotate them around. If they were in the outfield they would come into the infield, 3 infielders will go in to bat (kick), etc.
